A thesis statement is a roadmap that guides the sentence of the introductory paragraph. reader through your paper. It is usually the last

- Express the main idea of the paper (cover
- Present an argument (have an opinion)
- Guides the reader to your conclusion
- Fit the scope of the assignment (are you writing a paper or a book?)
