

Snow Day Make-Up

Parents, Guardians and Students: You may be wondering how the missed days due to weather affect make-up days, so we have put together some answers to these concerns

We have been encouraged by the Office of the Interim Superintendent, Dr. Ben to apply make-up days to Monday, March 11th and Tuesday, March 12th due to the winter conditions that impacted our school district.

As a result, our Spring Break will be shortened by two (2) days. In addition, we will also be having regular full school days on all 1/2 days-Wednesday's beginning March 20th through the remainder of school year. Please plan accordingly to the new school dates and schedules.

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 15-341.01, Window Rock Unified School District must provide 180 days of instruction each year so each day missed must be made up. We will continue to keep you updated with new information as soon as possible by the WRUSD website: wrschool.net, Facebook, district newsletters, and automatic school messaging

At this point, we know these school closures and delays have not been easy for any of us, but please understand that the safety of our students and staff is our number one priority and will always be the basis for any decision to amend the school day.
